-Don't hang up - be ready to give more details and follow directions from the operator.

-Stop accidental calls - lock your keypad.

-Never give out personal information.

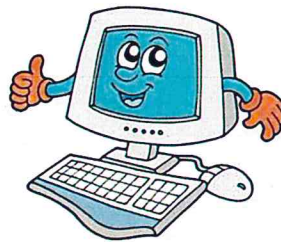
-Never send a picture of yourself to anyone.
