At Angelina Federal Employees Credit Union, we are committed to serving our members, before, during and after a disaster or storm. Although our office will close if mandatory evacuation is called, or for other reasons to keep our members and employees safe. Our digital services will remain available for our members, giving you access to your accounts and funds. All ACH deposits, share draft postings, debit and credit card transactions will process as normal.

In the event a disaster affects the Credit Union, a disaster recovery site will be set up to ensure that all services continue or are restored as quickly as possible.

AFECU will utilize our website, <u>www.afecu.net</u>, email, social media, or other electronic delivery channels to keep our members up to date on credit union operations.

The Credit Union will reopen its office as soon as it is safe to do so.
