

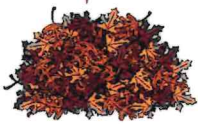

Cover your pinecone in peanut butter. Roll the PB pinecone in seeds to give it a good coat. Tie a loop of yarn or ribbon to the top of the pinecone to hang.
